#### Question 1

Question 1: For the existing Digital Health Applied Leadership Program (DHALP) countries, i.e., Cameroon, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Guinea, Malawi, and Zimbabwe, will the service provider be expected to travel for primary qualitative data collection, e.g., key and group informant interviews?

Answer 1: PATH does not dictate if primary data collection should occur in person or through virtual formats.
